The food was served by prisoners including the perpetrator of NZ's largest Ponzi scheme, David Ross, immediately recognisable to many in our group.

The café had a range of cakes and breads available for sale, all cooked by prisoners, and eagerly pedalled by Davis Ross, showing off his salesmanship skills.

Unfortunately, the prison was undergoing some building work within the grounds and we were unable to be taken the usual tour inside the prison area. Despite this, it was an interesting and entertaining outing for all who attended.
