New Sydney Fish Market
Wednesday 29 April

The new Sydney Fish Market offers a unique visitor experience. Train departs Dapto **8:23am**, Wollongong **8:37am**, Thirroul **8:48am**, arrive Central **10:02am**, transfer to light rail - follow the signs to light rail and catch the L1 Dulwich Hill line. Wentworth Park is the closest light rail stop on this line, located approximately 400 metres from the new market.

Taronga Zoo Sydney
Wednesday 6 May

Cost: \$37 concession. Please note that the Zoo is cashless. Train departs Dapto **8:23am**, Wollongong **8:37am**, Thirroul **8:48am**, change at Central for (L2,L3) light rail to Circular Quay. Ferry to Mosman. (Ferry departs every 30 minutes). Bus 238 connects with the ferry wharf at lower entrance, takes you to the top entrance to enter the Zoo. At the completion of your visit you can walk down hill through the Zoo and catch the ferry back to Circular Quay for your return trip to Wollongong. Payment by **April**
