Wednesday 24 February	Train trip to Kiama and return	Enjoy an outing to explore, shop or stay on for the Farmers Market in the afternoon. Train departs Thirroul 9.43, Wollongong 9.59 and Dapto 10.21 arriving Kiama at 10.48. Try and sit in the first 2 carriages if you can. MASK MUST BE WORN ON THE TRAIN. Trains leave every hour at 5 minutes to the hour on the return journey.
Wednesday 31 March	Tour of Mt Keira Scout Camp	Cost \$6. – A one hour tour of the Scout Camp followed by morning tea. We will hear the history of the Scout Camp, visit the Bush Chapel, the Glen and the Lodge. Meet at the car park at 9.45. If you require a lift, please let us know. Payment February
Thursday 29 April	Blue Mile History Tour	Cost \$17.00 – meet at 9.30am at Flagstaff Hill (Lighthouse) for a 2.5hr leisurely walk to Belmore Basin and along the Blue Mile, listening to our guide, Sue Meehan, discussing the history of the area. Stop for morning tea at the half way point at own expense Payment March
Friday 28 May	Train trip to Berry	Visit Berry and explore the historical buildings or the many shops and cafes. Train departs Thirroul 8.41, Wollongong 8.53, Dapto 9.07 (try and sit in the second front carriage if you can).
