| Friday 28 May | Train trip to Berry | Visit Berry and explore the historical buildings or the many shops and cafes. Train departs Thirroul 8.41am, Wollongong 8:53, Dapto 9:07 (try and sit in the second front carriage if you can). Change trains at Kiama for a smaller train to Berry and then a 10 minute walk into town. Meet back at Berry station in time to catch the 1:25pm train which arrives at Dapto at 2:22pm, Wollongong 2:37pm and Thirroul 2:48pm. |
| Thursday 3 June | Tour of Thirlmere Railway Museum | Cost \$36.00 which includes tour and bus. Coffee and tea on arrival followed by a 90 minute guided tour of the Museum (approx.. 1km of level walking). Lunch at Picton Bowling Club own expense. Meet at Fraternity Club at 8:15am .
