FROM THE PRESIDENT

Having just returned after a lovely holiday in Japan we can certainly appreciate all that Adelaide offers, especially its trees, gardens, playgrounds and our spacious surroundings. What a contrast with Japan's high rise buildings, unbelievable bridges, trains, tunnels and sophisticated industries. My dream would be to import the Shinkansen train network all over Australia! We have been to Japan several times and have always been impressed by their culture, incredible politeness, cleanliness and friendliness.

As a member of UNESCO I was determined to visit Hiroshima. The Hiroshima Peace Memorial (Genbaku Dome) is the only structure left standing near the hypocenter of the first atomic bomb explosion on 6 August 1945, and it remains in the condition right after the explosion. Through the efforts of many people, including those of the city of Hiroshima, this ruin has been preserved in the same state as immediately after the bombing. Not only is it a stark and powerful symbol of the most destructive force ever created by humankind, it also expresses the hope for world peace and the ultimate elimination of all nuclear weapons. The 42.7 ha buffer zone that surrounds the property includes the Peace Memorial Park.



The most important meaning of the surviving structure of the Hiroshima Peace Memorial is in what it symbolises, rather than just its aesthetic and architectural values. This silent structure is the skeletal form of the surviving remains of the Hiroshima Prefectural Industrial Promotional Hall (constructed in 1914). It symbolises the tremendous destructive power, which humankind can invent on the one hand; on the other hand, it also reminds us of the hope for world permanent peace.'(UNESCO)
