October is Probus Month when all clubs throughout Australia celebrate the occasion with various activities.

Probus originated in the United Kingdom, with the development of two community-based social clubs in the 1960s. In 1965, the Campus Club was formed by the Rotary Club of Welwyn, Garden City, just north of London. In 1966, the first Probus Club was established by the Rotary Club of Caterham.

The first club formed in Australia was the Probus Club of Hunters Hill in February 1976. It celebrated its 40th anniversary in February 2016.

Glen Osmond Probus Club was formed on June 1, 1982 and was named "Glen Osmond and Burnside Probus. After 5 months, it was decided to separate the clubs as they had grown so rapidly. However, it remained a Men's club until 2012 when it changed to mixed gender membership.

You can read about our club on the GOPC website as Brian Rice has provided us with all the club's records and history.

The name is an amalgam of the abbreviation of the words professional and business. Probus is also a Latin word meaning honest or virtuous, from which the English word "probity" is derived.

To celebrate our 42 years the club will have a special morning tea on Monday, 7 October. Blue and Yellow is the theme whether it's a hat, tie, or outfit. Come colourfully attired.
