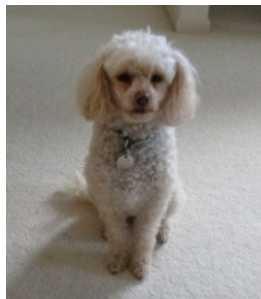

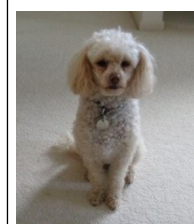
- *The only real mistake is the one from which we learn nothing.

GUEST SPEAKER:- Geraldine Triffitt gave us an interesting talk about life in the Fijian village of Soso on Naviti Island in 1977, Geraldine and her husband Tom became regular visitors to the village. Onesimo Nayato, who is a resident of the village, became a good friend to Geraldine and Tom. He was good natured and he shared the culture of his village with Geraldine and Tom. Tom died in 1985. Geraldine wrote a book about her experiences on the island, using information provided by Onesimo. She said that the book told a story of the social life, environment, flora and fauna of a culture that has had little contact with Europeans over the years. It was intended to describe the changes in life in the village from her first visit to the present day when



tourists at the nearby island resorts or cruise boats included a visit to Soso.
