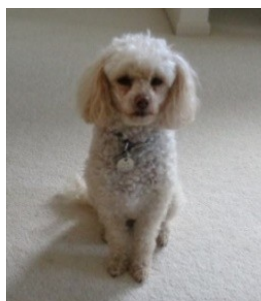

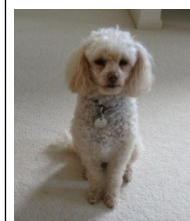

was about the new "My Health Record" service. Kate works as an Enrolled Nurse at Canberra Hospital and the Red Cross. She is currently working as the Community Engagement Officer at Capital Health Network. The focus of her role is to work locally on the My Health Record expansion program.

Her talk explained how, by the end of 2018, a “My Health Record” will be created for every Australian, unless you choose not to have one. My Health Record provides for potentially lifesaving access to your key health information such as medications, allergies, and condition. Health information can be shared with doctors, hospitals and other health care providers from anywhere, anytime.
