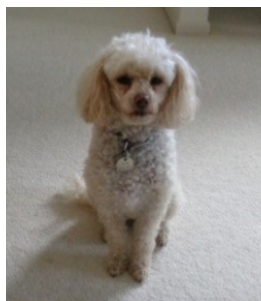

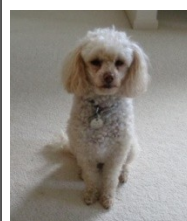

"The Club shall be managed by a committee (herein after called the Committee) comprising of a President, Vice President, Secretary,

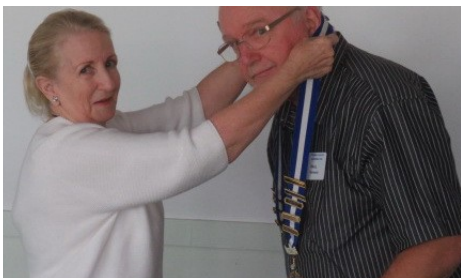
