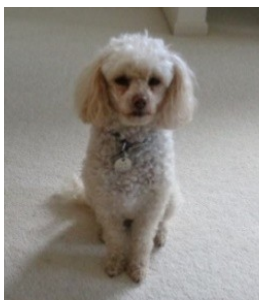

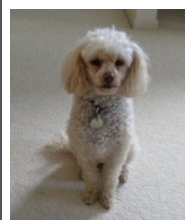

**Guest Speaker:** The guest speaker for May was Ren Webb. Ren is a technical officer with the ACT Government's "Actsmart Sustainable Home Advice". His talk was called "Five Steps to an Energy-Efficient Home". He told us that he had dramatically improved his own home for little cost. Ren spent less than \$4000 and took the energy efficiency rating of his 1970s Canberra home from 2 Stars to 6.9 Stars.

With the addition of a solar system, his house now generates five times more energy than used by his family.

He provides free advice to the Canberra community and delivers public workshops on a range of home sustainability topics. He told us about improving a home's thermal performance, upgrading to high-efficiency electric appliances, moving off gas and switching to solar.
