

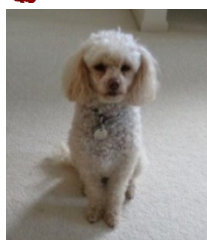

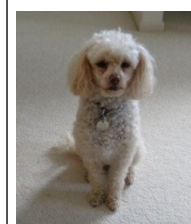

**Guest Speaker:** The guest speaker in August was Jenny Horsfield. Jenny spoke about the “The Soldier Settlers of Tuggeranong”. Jenny Horsfield is a Canberra writer and historian. In early 2018 she curated an exhibition at Lanyon Homestead about the soldier settlers. The stories of these men and the hardships they endured has led to the publishing of her latest book on the topic.

In her talk she told us how, in 1920, eight men who had served in the Great War took up soldier settler blocks at Tuggeranong, on land that had formerly belonged to the Cunningham family. They faced years of uncertain markets, isolation, drought, weed infestation and the rabbit plague, in a decade that was to test the strongest of men and culminate in the Great Depression.

Jenny is also the author of 'Rainbow: the story of Rania MacPhillamy', the story of a young woman who served as a VAD in Egypt during the Great War and "Building a City", about early Canberra.
