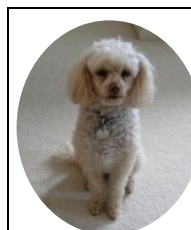

Guest Speaker: The Guest Speaker in October was Elizabeth Samra from Legal Aid ACT. Elizabeth has been active in advocating for the rights of older people for almost a decade. She is currently working with Legal Aid ACT on a project to develop its elder law practice, with a focus on elder abuse and family violence. She is with a specialist service within Legal Aid ACT called OPALS (Older Persons ACT Legal Service). OPALS provides legal help to older people in Canberra. They can help with legal issues involving elder abuse, enduring powers of attorney, guardianship and financial arrangements with family members.

In her talk Elizabeth gave lots of advice on the problems that can occur if powers of attorney and other legal documents are not properly drawn up. She gave numerous examples of cases where people hadn't done things correctly and the unfortunate consequences that followed.
