The winner was Terry White. Hope you had a happy birthday, Terry.

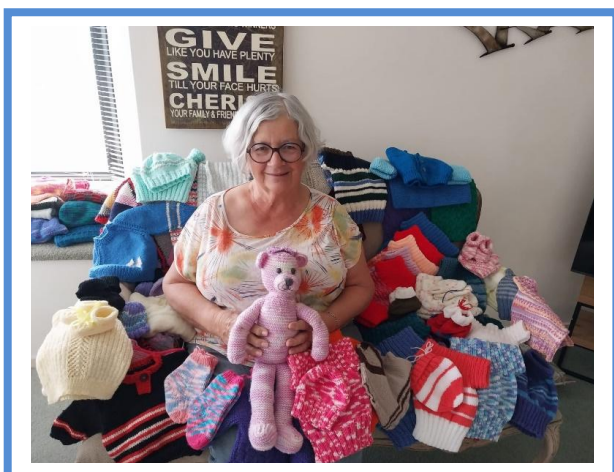
If you weren't at the meeting on Friday you might like to know:
