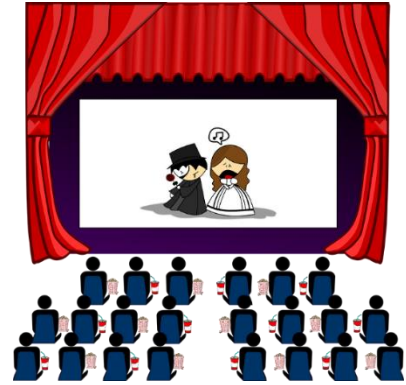

Thursday November 9<sup>th</sup> 2023 will be the

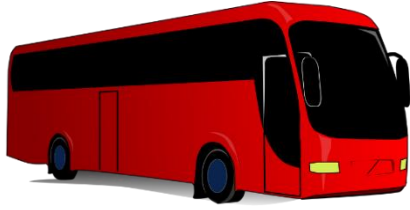
