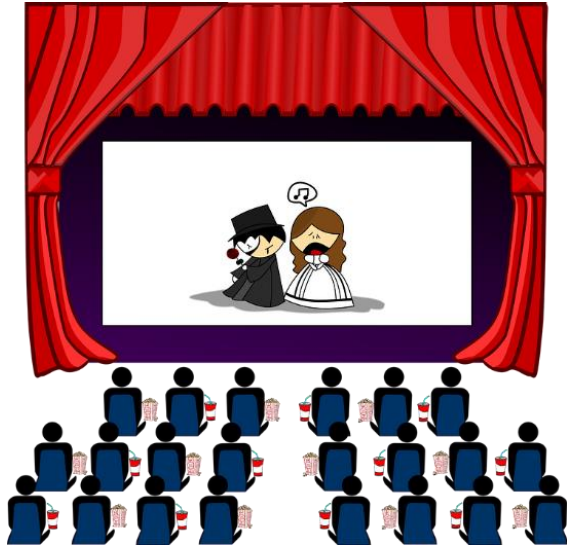
Happy New Year everyone and welcome back to the Probus year of 2023. Hope everyone had a great Christmas and New Year and we're all ready to get back into the swing of things.

I am organising the Opal Trips to Cockatoo Island and Sydney Olympic Park

travelling by train to Circular Quay and by ferry to our destinations. There has been some confusion regarding the dates of these outings.

The Cockatoo Island day is the 21st February, and the SOP outing is on the 14th March, as per the calendar in the December newsletter. Both dates are a Tuesday.

The interest sheets that were put out at the Christmas Party showed the events in reverse order (SOP in February and CI in March). I apologise for the error and should have picked it up earlier. Please check the interest sheets when we return on 25th January.

I did a reconnaissance trip to Cockatoo Island yesterday and I think the best approach would be for everyone to do their own thing, either in small groups or by themselves. There are 2 cafes, one as you get off the ferry, and the other one is on the other side of the island, which is about 400-500 metres away. At both cafes there is a seating area, under shade, where you can enjoy a coffee, tea, a bite to eat, or even a bottle of wine or cocktail while enjoying the sites of the Parramatta River. (the cafes are licences) You could take your own lunch if you wanted.

The dock area is on flat ground but if you want to visit the historic area which takes in the Convict and historic residences there is quite a climb either up stairs or rather steep driveway. I obtained a Visitor Guide (cost \$5) and will leave it with the interest sheet for perusal on the 25th. Maps are available at the visitor centre for free and headphones are available at a cost of \$6 which gives you a rundown of each point of interest.

I will give further updates at our meeting and don't hesitate to ask any questions.
